



## NON-DOMESTIC USERS

### FIRST DISTRIBUTION OF NEW BAGS

Non-domestic users, like domestic users, must collect their first supply of blue bags at the distribution points set up throughout the area.

### CAUTION!

**Non-domestic users who are currently using 1,100 litre bins for the collection of general waste, will be contacted by AGESP for the application of the RFID tag associated with the user on the bins already in operation.** Hence, they will not have to collect the blue bags but can continue to dispose of their waste in clear bags in the proper bins.

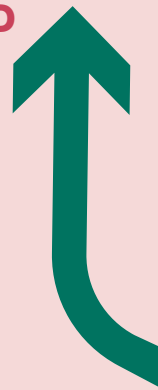

## THE NEW RFID TAG-ENABLED BLUE BAG HAS ARRIVED

### WHAT HAS CHANGED?

For the collection of general dry waste, the exclusive use of the new blue 80-litre bags equipped with RFID tags, paired with each waste tax holder, becomes mandatory.

### WHAT DOES RFID STAND FOR?

RFID stands for Radio Frequency Identification. The new blue bags are equipped with a special code that will enable the waste displayed to be associated with the user who produced it.

### WHY CHANGE?

Thanks to the adoption of RFID-enabled bags, each TARI waste tax holder becomes responsible for the non-recyclable waste he or she produces.



### CAUTION!

By summer 2024, no more bags other than the blue RFID bags provided by AGESP S.p.A. for the collection of general waste will be collected.



## HOW TO GET THE NEW BAGS

### THE FIRST SUPPLY DISTRICT BY DISTRICT

By summer 2024, the new blue bags will be distributed throughout the city. A roll of 13 80-litre bags will be supplied to each user.

TARI tax holders will have to show their health card at the distribution points provided in each district, as stated in the letter delivered with this brochure.

### IF I AM UNABLE TO COLLECT

If collection of the first supply is not possible on the dates indicated, they will be available:

- **at vending machines** around the city (24 hours a day, 7 days a week). List available on [www.agesp.it](http://www.agesp.it)
- **from the AGESP Environmental Hygiene Desk** in Via Canale 26 during opening hours.

**Subsequent supplies of blue bags can also be collected from vending machines and/or from the User Desk in Via Canale 26.**

### MAXIMUM ANNUAL SUPPLY PER HOUSEHOLD

- no. 2 rolls up to 4 household members;
- no. 3 rolls over 4 household members.



## THE ADVANTAGES OF THE NEW SYSTEM



### 1 LESS WASTE

The system provides an incentive to produce less general waste.
